
# SINCE 2013 CORPORATES HAVE CONTRACTED 13.5 GW OF WIND ENERGY THROUGH PPAs

This is equivalent to the combined total wind energy capacity of the Netherlands and Belgium. 2/3rds of all corporate PPAs (Power Purchase Agreements) signed so far were with wind.




### 2021 WAS A RECORD YEAR FOR CORPORATES BUYING WIND ENERGY


Corporates signed a record 4.5 GW of wind energy capacity through PPA deals in 2021.



### **KEY TRENDS:**

- ICT have contracted the largest volume of wind PPAs, followed by aluminium smelters and chemicals companies.
- PPAs are being signed in more countries.
  In 2021, wind energy PPAs were signed in 13 different countries in Europe.
- Offshore wind PPAs have taken off since 2018. Now more than 2.5 GW of offshore wind has been contracted through PPAs.
- Sweden, Norway and Finland lead the way in Europe with over 50% of wind PPA volumes signed in these three countries alone.
